



## Checklist On How To Clean Up Your Perennials

### Tools needed

- \_\_\_\_\_ Hand Clippers
- \_\_\_\_\_ Watering Can
- \_\_\_\_\_ Container With Last Years Perennials
- \_\_\_\_\_ 6 Pack Of Perennials

### What To Do

- \_\_\_\_\_ Clip or trim off the leggy branches.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Be careful not to break unintended branches.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Clean out old leaves, snails, and winter debris.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Stir up the soil in the bare areas and add some potting soil to bring up the soil level to grade.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Take a couple of new plants from the 6 pack, loosen up the roots and plant in the open area in the container.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Water your renewed container, this will reduce shock to the plants from having their roots stirred up.
