



Glue PVC Checklist

Tools you need to cut and glue PVC pipe

- _____ Hacksaw, Hacksaw Blade, or PVC Cutter
- _____ Sandpaper or file
- _____ Latex Gloves
- _____ Old clothes
- _____ Weld on PVC Glue (correct type of glue for correct application)
- _____ Glue dauber
- _____ Old rag or paper towel

Caution glue will stain your clothes. Protect surfaces from drips of glue.

- _____ Mark and cut pipe at correct length.
- _____ Smooth burrs at end of pipe with sand paper or file.
- _____ Clean surfaces you intend to bond with PVC glue and make sure debris, dirt or shavings do not get into pipe. This can plug nozzles or valves.
- _____ According to the manufacturer recommendation always apply purple primer before gluing.
- _____ Determine which PVC glue is best for your application.
- _____ Apply glue to pipe and fitting.
- _____ Immediately slide pipe and fitting together twisting up to quarter turn. Hold the pipe and fitting firmly together for a few seconds to keep the fitting from sliding off the pipe.
